

Dear Ms. Petersen:

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), Solid Waste Plan Review Unit has received and reviewed the Harrison Road Landfill Poor Water Quality Groundwater Permit (No. 59-583889.0001): 2nd Half 2013 Report, Groundwater Monitoring Results and Remediation System Performance Report, dated January 27, 2014, prepared by the City of Tucson.

As noted in the report, the remediation system has successfully remediated tetrachloroethene (PCE) and trichloroethene (TCE) concentrations in the groundwater to below the Aguifer Water Quality Standard (AWQS) of 5.0 µg/L in all remediation and monitor wells. ADEQ acknowledges that the City of Tucson Environmental Services will be submitting a Type III Change to the approved Facility Plan to shut-off the groundwater treatment system. The report was found to be complete in accordance with permit requirements and will be placed in the Harrison Road Landfill facility file.
